the wet season as well as the park also host a population of the rare tree-climbing lions. We wil enoy our dinner and spend the night at Twiga Lodge.

**Day 5:** We will drive to Tarangire National Park just after breakfast. Tarangire's signature attractions are elephants and baobabs - hugely impressive trees that can live for several thousand years, providing wonderful silhouettes for sunset photos and interesting selfies as well. In the late afternoon we will drive to Arusha and drop you at your hotel - after an once of a lifetime experience.

Please note that the program is flexible and can be tailor-made on your request.



If you want to start in Arusha and end in Arusha - it's also possible. Just send us an e-mail with your suggestions and we will make a personal program for you.
