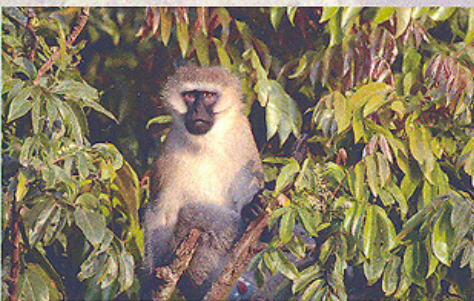


Rubondo Island Safari

Lake Victoria



3 days/2 nights at Rubondo National Park

Visit Rubondo Island - The National Park in Lake Victoria, Tanzania; Peaceful, pristine and very, very exciting. See and be very near lots of monkeys, hippos, elephants (few) and some HUGE (5 meter long and very angry) Nile Crocodiles - even up close (BUT safe). Rubondo Island is also a well known paradise for bird lovers - as more than 400 species have been recorded so far.

Program:

- ♦ Mwanza - Mwanza (and back) by saloon/4WD car with English speaking driver/guide (about 5 hours).
- ♦ Ferry transfer at Kigongo (25 minutes).
- ♦ Shopping stop and lunch break in Geita (lunch box and cold soft drinks/water are provided).
- ♦ Boat transfer to the island (45 minutes) and transfer to the bandas by 4WD car.
- ♦ Accommodation in Tanapa bandas (photo) with all modern facilities.
- ♦ 3 hours boat safari on Lake Victoria in a Tanapa boat - together with a park ranger.
- ♦ Walking safari - guided by Tanapa Park Rangers.

Full board: Breakfast, lunch and dinner prepared and served by your private chef.
All park fees are included.

Rates (total):

2 persons - 3 days/2 nights:	1.320 US\$
3 persons - 3 days/2 nights:	1.600 US\$
4 persons - 3 days/2 nights:	2.100 US\$
